The closing date for applications is 11am on Wednesday 11th January 2023

To qualify to become a Parish Councillor you must:

- be a British subject over 18 years old
- be listed on the current electoral role and live in Claybrooke Magna or within 3 miles of its boundary; or occupy as owner/tenant any land/premises therein; or have a principal place of work within the Parish.

You must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor due to having a conviction or enforcement action subject to one or more of the following:

- the notification requirements in the Sexual Offences Act 2003
- a Sexual Risk Order
- a Civil Injunction
- a Criminal Behaviour Order
